

CITY OF WINDY HILLS

Ordinance No. 94-03

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE LICENSING AND SALE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF WINDY HILLS:

Section 1. No person shall do any act authorized by any kind of license with respect to the manufacture, storage, sale, purchase, transporting or other traffic in alcoholic beverages in the City unless he holds the kind of license that authorized such act issued by the City Clerk.

Section 2. The following kinds of distilled spirits and wine licenses may be issued by the City, the fees for which shall be:

(a) Distiller's license, per annum	\$ 500.00
(b) Rectifier's license, per annum	1500.00
(c) Blender's license, per annum	1500.00
(d) Wholesaler's license, per annum	1500.00
(e) Retail package license, per annum	600.00
(f) Retail drink license, per annum	800.00
(g) Special temporary license, per month or part of month, one-sixth of fee enumerated in subsection (f)	
(h) Special private club license, per annum	150.00
(i) Special Sunday retail drink license	300.00
(j) Nonresident, special agent or solicitor's license, per annum	20.00
(k) Special temporary wine license	25.00
(l) Caterer's license, per annum	400.00
(m) Supplemental bar license	800.00
(n) Restaurant wine license	
i.) New applicants	300.00
ii.) Renewals	200.00

Section 3. The following kinds of malt beverage licenses may be issued by the City, the fees for which shall be:

(a) Brewer's license, per annum	\$ 500.00
(b) Microbrewery license, per annum	250.00
(c) Distributor's license, per annum	200.00
(d) Retailer's license, per annum	
i. New applicants	200.00
ii. Renewals	150.00
(e) Special temporary license, per month or part thereof	12.50


Section 4. The business authorized by the licenses provided for herein shall correspond to the business authorized by the corresponding licenses authorized by KRS Chapter 243 and KRS Chapter 446 and specifically including the definitions contained in KRS 446.010.

Section 5. Any person who, by himself, or acting through another, directly or indirectly, violates any of the provisions of this ordinance for which no other penalty is provided, shall for the first offense, be fined not less than One Hundred (\$100) Dollars nor more than Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars, or be imprisoned in the County jail for not more than six months, or both; and for the second and each subsequent violation, he shall be fined not less than Two Hundred (\$200) Dollars nor more than Five Hundred (\$500) Dollars, or be imprisoned in the County jail for not more than six months, or both. Each sale in violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate offense. Penalties provided for herein shall be in addition to the revocation or suspension of the offender's license.


Section 6. All licenses issued hereunder shall expire on June 30 next following their effective date of issue. The license provided in Sections 2 and 3 hereof, if such license is issued between January 1 and June 30 of the license year, shall be one-half of the fee so specified in Sections 2 and 3 for all such licenses except temporary licenses as provided in Section 2(g) and Section 3(d).

Section 7. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and publication as required by law and apply to all licenses issued by the City, the effective date of which is on or after July 1, 1994, except that the licenses authorized by Section 1 (k), (l), (m) and (n) shall become effective on July 15, 1994.
