

ORDINANCE NO. 105, SERIES 1978

CITY OF WINDY HILLS

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO GARBAGE AND REFUSE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WINDY HILLS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. Definitions: As used in this Ordinance, the words "Garbage," and "Refuse," have the following meanings:

(a) Garbage: Wastes resulting from the handling, preparation, cooking and consumption of food; Waste from the handling, storage and sale of produce.

(b) Refuse: Combustible trash, including, but not limited to, paper, cartons, boxes, barrels, wood, tree branches, yard trimmings; non-combustible trash including, but not limited to, metals, tin cans, dirt, small quantities of rock and pieces of concrete, glass, mineral waste, ashes and rubbish.

2. Uncovered Garbage. It shall be unlawful to place or permit or remain anywhere in the City any garbage, or other materials subject to decay other than leaves or grass, excepting in a tightly covered container.

3. Wind-blown Refuse. It shall be unlawful to cause or permit to accumulate any dust, ashes, or trash of such a material that can be blown away by the wind anywhere in the City excepting in a covered container.

4. Collection by City. The City shall, by contract, have charge of the collection of garbage and refuse in the City under contract with a garbage collection firm. Such garbage collection firm shall pick up on a regularly scheduled basis no less than once each week up to three (3) twenty gallon containers from a reasonable location convenient to the resident from each single-family residence and condominium in the City plus shrubbery trimmings in reasonable amounts placed at the street curbing in containers or in tied bundles not exceeding three feet in length.


5. Time for Placement and Removal. No garbage or refuse, including shrubbery trimmings, grass clippings, or other materials for pick-up by the garbage collector shall be placed at the curbing, or in the front yard of any residence, prior to noon on the day before the next regularly scheduled pick-up day for that residence and no such garbage or refuse, or containers therefor, shall be permitted to remain at the curbing or in the front yard of any residence after 7:00 p.m. on such collection day.

6. Hot Ashes. No person shall place any ashes in any container for removal by the garbage collection firm until all such ashes have cooled to room temperature.


7. Deposit in City. It shall be unlawful to deposit or permit to be deposited or stored in the City any garbage or refuse except that the owner, occupant or tenant of property in the City may store such garbage or refuse as is generated by the normal legal use of his or its property thereon only for such time as is required for normal pick up and disposal.

8. Penalty. Any person, firm or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$5 nor more than \$200 for each offense, and a separate offense shall be deemed committed on each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues. The fact that garbage or refuse remains on any occupants premises in this City in violation of this ordinance shall be prima facie evidence that the occupant of such premises is responsible for the violation of the ordinance occurring.
